#### **Windows**

- Microsoft Windows 95 OSR 2.0, Windows 98 SE, Windows Millennium Edition, Windows NT 4.0 with Service Pack 5, Windows 2000, or Windows XP
- 64MB of RAM
- 24MB of available hard-disk space

### **Macintosh PowerPC processor**

#### Installation
